



Barrington Street Closure - Sunday, March 14

Dartmouth, NS – The Halifax Harbour Bridges (HHB) advises motorists that the section of Barrington Street located directly under the MacKay Bridge (at the area where the street becomes two lanes) will be closed to all traffic on Sunday, March 14 from 6:30 am to 12:00 noon

Please note that during this closure there will be no south-bound access to Barrington Street from the MacKay Bridge, Massachusetts Avenue or the Fairview overpass.

Outbound traffic will be diverted to Duffus Street. Inbound traffic will be diverted to Massachusetts/Robie.

The closure is required to position platforms for work that is required on the cable bent bearing struts (part of the MacKay Bridge that is located below the deck, immediately adjacent to Barrington Street).

This closure is being done on a Sunday morning to minimize disruption to the travelling public.
