



Resurfacing Victoria Road as part of interchange project

The Halifax-Dartmouth Bridge Commission (HDBC) continues its restoration of the Victoria Road Interchange (VRI) with resurfacing the section of Victoria Road that spans Highway 111 (the Circumferential) in Dartmouth.

Work has begun to resurface the portion of Victoria Road that spans Highway 111 (the Circumferential). Milling and repaving of the area will continue until Saturday, May 9. Following the work temporary pavement markers will be in place.

To minimize disruption to the flow of traffic, Victoria Road will be fully open during peak periods and one lane in each direction will remain open at other times. There will be occasional ramp closures required outside of peak traffic hours (9am-4pm) as work proceeds along the entrance or exit to a ramp. Detours will be in place during these detours.

The Halifax-Dartmouth Bridge Commission thanks the travelling public for their patience during the restoration of the Victoria Road Interchange.
