Lane closures on Macdonald Bridge for the Olympic torch relay

November 16, 2009 (Dartmouth, NS) – The Halifax Harbour Bridges advises motorists that two lanes on the Macdonald Bridge will be closed for a 40 minute period on Wednesday, November 18th from approximately 2:40pm to 3:20pm. Motorists should expect delays.

The closure will be taking place to accommodate the Olympic torch relay that will be moving across Nova Scotia from November 16th to 20th, 2009. Please note that the closure could be slightly delayed depending on the progress of the torch relay.

One lane will remain open for the duration of the event for traffic travelling Dartmouth bound. The pedestrian lane and bicycle lane will remain open to regular traffic during this time.
